§ 41-1001 Designation of Snow Emergency Routes.

The following streets are hereby designated snow emergency routes within the Borough:

9. Main Street (North and South, partly SR 3001)	School Street	Northern Borough line

§ 41-1002 Declaration of Snow Emergency.

The Mayor or the Borough Council may declare a snow emergency when deemed appropriate. The Borough shall announce and publicize the declaration at repeated intervals and by appropriate available methods until the snow emergency has ended.

§ 41-1003 Parking Restriction.

No vehicle may be parked on either side of a snow emergency route at any time during the existence of a snow emergency declared by the Mayor or Borough Council. All vehicles parked on streets designated as snow emergency routes under § 41-1001 shall be subject to removal without notice by the Borough during a declared snow emergency.

§ 41-1004 Vehicles Impeding Snow Removal.

Any vehicle found to impede the Borough in the removal of snow from snow emergency routes following the proclamation of a snow emergency shall be deemed to constitute a nuisance, shall be subject to removal without notice, and shall subject the owner to liability and penalty therefor.

§ 41-1005 Reclaiming Removed Vehicles.

Any vehicle removed by the Borough during a declared snow emergency shall be returned to the possession of the owner upon payment by the owner of costs of removal and storage.
