## Article I — General Provisions

### § 41-101 Short Title.

This Chapter shall be known, and may be cited, as the “Alburtis Traffic Control Ordinance”.

### § 41-102 Definitions and Interpretation.

Words and phrases, when used in this Chapter, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania, Chapter 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, as now in force or as hereafter amended, enacted or reenacted, except in those instances where the context clearly indicates a different meaning. The singular shall include the plural, and the masculine shall include the feminine.

### § 41-103 Authority of Police Officers.

The police officers of the Borough are hereby given authority to direct traffic on the highways of the Borough and at intersections thereof.

### § 41-104 Official Signs.

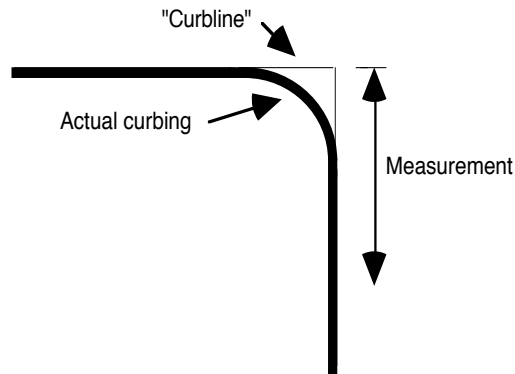
The Borough shall erect and maintain official traffic control devices for all restrictions set forth in Articles III through XI (*except* § 41-503 (relating to State Law Prohibitions Which Are Also Local Prohibitions)) in accordance with the design, placement, and other requirements of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation regulations. *See also* § 41-803 (relating to Handicapped Parking Spaces), § 41-901 (relating to painted parking stall lines) and § 41-1202(b) (relating to Tow-Away Zone signs).

### § 41-105 Definition of Curblines; Measurements.

When used in this Chapter, the term “curblines” generally means the actual curblines where a curb is present, and the edge of paving where a curb is not present. However, at the intersections of two streets where one or more of the corners are rounded by a radius, the “curblines” shall not follow the actual curbing or edge of cartway, but shall continue into the intersection in a straight line at the same bearing established behind the radius. Accordingly, the starting point

for measurements from a curblines of an intersecting street shall be at the projected intersection of the “curblines” (which will be within the cartway when a radius is present, rather than along a curb or the edge of paving):



All measurements of starting and ending points regarding the locations of parking and/standing restrictions set forth in Articles V through X shall be made along the curblines on the indicated side of the street for which the restriction is imposed.

## Article II — Special Temporary or Emergency Powers

### § 41-201 Authority Granted to Chief of Police.

The Chief of Police may, for special temporary purposes, restrict or prohibit all traffic and/or parking on particular highways or parts thereof where otherwise it would be permitted, or may permit traffic and/or parking on particular highways or parts thereof where otherwise it would be prohibited. Such temporary special occasions shall include time allowed for construction activities, maintenance activities, painting of lines, parades, exhibitions, demonstrations, celebrations, and other similar uses, and like permission or prohibition may be imposed or granted where special temporary uses are being made in premises immediately adjoining the highway wherein unusual usages of the highway may be deemed necessary.

## Article III — Speed Limits

### § 41-301 25 mph Zones.

The maximum speed limit shall be twenty-five miles per hour (25 m.p.h.) within the following zones on the following streets at all times:

**§ 41-503 State Law Prohibitions Which Are Also Local Prohibitions.**

Except as otherwise permitted under 75 PA. CONS. STAT. § 3353 or § 3354, the following actions when prohibited under the State Vehicle Code shall also be prohibited under this Chapter and constitute violations of this Chapter:

(a) No person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle:

(1) On the roadway side of any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb of a street (*i.e.* double parking);

(2) On a sidewalk;

(3) Within an intersection;

(4) On a crosswalk; or

(5) Alongside or opposite any street excavation or obstruction where to do so would obstruct traffic.

(b) No person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle:

(1) In front of a public or private driveway;

(2) Within fifteen (15) feet of a fire hydrant;

(3) Within twenty (20) feet of a crosswalk at an intersection;

(4) Within thirty (30) feet upon the approach to any flashing signal, stop sign, yield sign, or traffic-control signal located at the side of a roadway;

(5) Within twenty (20) feet of the driveway entrance to any fire station;

(6) On a two-way street if the vehicle is not positioned parallel to and with the right-hand wheels within twelve (12) inches of the right-hand curb.

(c) No person shall park a vehicle:

(1) Within fifty (50) feet of the nearest rail of a railroad crossing.

(d) No person shall park or leave unattended a vehicle:

(1) On private property (other than in a private parking lot) without the consent of the owner or other person in control or possession of the property;

(2) In a private parking lot (a privately owned parking lot open to the public for parking with or without restrictions or charge) which is properly posted in accordance with 67 PA. CODE § 218.115 to notify the public of any parking restrictions, if the operator of the vehicle violates such posted restrictions.

No parking shall be allowed in any handicapped parking space designated in § 41-802 or § 41-802.1 by any vehicle other than one which bears an HP or DV license plate, or displays a handicapped person or severely disabled veteran parking placard, issued by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation and, in the case of a space designated in § 41-802, which is registered in the name of the disabled person identified in § 41-802 for that space or another person residing with that person.

### § 41-802 Designated Spaces—Residential.

### § 41-805 Applications for Handicapped Parking Spaces.

(a) **In General.** All applications for handicapped parking spaces must be made in writing on forms prescribed by the Borough Manager. The person making the application (“**Applicant**”) need not be the person (“**Disabled Person**”) the handicapped parking space is intended to accommodate.

(b) **Criteria.** Council shall have complete discretion whether to grant any particular request for a handicapped parking space, but shall generally grant a request which satisfies all of the following criteria:

(1) **PennDOT.** The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation has issued a permanent person with disabilities or disabled or severely disabled veteran license plate or placard with respect to the Disabled Person which is currently in effect. Temporary plates or placards are not sufficient;

(2) **Medical Condition.** A Pennsylvania licensed physician has certified, based on an examination conducted no more than six (6) months before the date of the application, that the Disabled Person:

- (A) cannot walk more than two hundred (200) feet without stopping to rest;
- (B) cannot walk without the use of, or assistance from, a walker, wheelchair, or another person;
- (C) cannot walk more than five hundred (500) feet without difficulty, even with the assistance of a brace, cane, crutch, prosthetic device, or other assistive device;
- (D) cannot cross roads;
- (E) uses portable oxygen;

(F) is restricted by lung disease to such an extent that the Disabled Person's forced (respiratory) expiration volume for one second, when measured by spirometry, is less than one (1) liter or the arterial oxygen tension is less than sixty (60) mmHg on room air at rest; or

(G) has a cardiac condition to the extent that the Disabled Person's functional limitations are classified in severity as Class III or Class IV according to the standards set by the American Heart Association; and

(3) **Off-Street Alternatives.** There is no off-street parking area (such as a garage, driveway, or parking lot) sufficient in size for a standard-sized automobile available for use by occupants of the Disabled Person's residence ("**Residence**"). The fact that such an area is actually being used for other purposes does not make the area "unavailable".

(c) **Location.** Council will generally establish a handicapped parking space at a location near to the street end of the primary paved surface used by the Disabled Person to access the Residence from a public street. Where the proposed handicapped parking space is located (all or partially) along the frontage of property not owned by a person residing at the Residence (including a landlord of the Residence and owners of property adjacent or near to the Residence or across the street from the Residence), the Applicant shall attempt to obtain the consent of the owner(s) of such property(ies) to the proposed handicapped parking space and submit it with the application or explain why it could not be obtained. Council reserves the right to deny a handicapped parking space where such consents are not provided, or grant a handicapped parking space despite the absence of such consents or the objection of other property owners.

(d) **Duration.** Handicapped parking spaces will generally be granted through the earlier of (A) the first December 31 following the fifth (5<sup>th</sup>) anniversary of the adoption of the ordinance approving the handicapped parking space, or (B) the last day that the Disabled Person is expected to need use of the handicapped parking space. However, Council reserves the right to rescind a handicapped parking space at any time by ordinance, especially when Council has reason to believe the criteria which justified the handicapped parking space no longer apply. The Applicant, Disabled Person, or family member or personal representative of the Disabled Person or his/her estate should inform the Borough Manager whenever any of the following occur:

(1) the Disabled Person dies;

(2) the Disabled Person no longer resides at the Residence;

(3) the Disabled Person's permanent person with disabilities or disabled or severely disabled veteran license plate or placard expires and has not been renewed, reissued, or replaced;  
or

(4) the Disabled Person's condition has improved so as to no longer satisfy subsection (b)(2).

## Article IX — Other Parking Restrictions

### § 41-901 Parking in Designated Stalls; Maximum Vehicle Length.

No vehicle shall be parked in any the following locations which is longer than twenty-two (22) feet from front extremity to back extremity (including any attached trailers and/or vehicles or parts of vehicles, and any protruding cargo), and no vehicle shall be parked in any of the following locations unless it is parked within a designated parking stall. All parts of the vehicle (including any attached trailers and/or vehicles or parts of vehicles, and any protruding cargo) must be within the designated stall; no part may extend beyond the front or back stall designation lines or the planes which pass through such lines and which are perpendicular to the street surface and extend upwards. The Borough shall paint parking stall lines within each of these zones to designate the permitted parking stalls, each of which shall be twenty-two (22) feet in length:

No vehicle may be parked on either side of a snow emergency route at any time during the existence of a snow emergency declared by the Mayor or Borough Council. ## Article XII — Enforcement

### § 41-1201 Violations and Penalties.

Except as otherwise provided in this Article or in § 41-804, any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Chapter shall be subject to prosecution before a magisterial district judge in the same manner as provided for a summary offense under the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure and, upon conviction thereof, shall be sentenced to pay a criminal fine of Forty-five Dollars (\$45.00) plus court costs and reasonable attorney fees incurred by the Borough in the enforcement proceedings.

### § 41-1202 Violations of § 41-502.

(a) **Penalty.** Any person who shall violate § 41-502 (relating to No Parking for Short Periods) shall be subject to prosecution before a magisterial district judge in the same manner as provided for a summary offense under the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure and, upon conviction thereof, shall be sentenced to pay a criminal fine of not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) and not more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00), plus court costs and reasonable attorney fees incurred by the Borough in the enforcement proceedings.

(b) **Removal of Vehicle.** It is the policy of the Borough that vehicles violating § 41-502 shall be removed from the street immediately in accordance with 75 PA. CONS. STAT. § 3352(c)(4). The Maintenance Department shall supplement each traffic control device erected in conjunction with § 41-502 with the optional R7-20 “Tow-Away Zone Sign” provided under 67 PA. CODE § 211.243. However, vehicles may still be removed from the street even in the absence of the “Tow-Away Zone Sign.”

### § 41-1203 Snow Emergency Violations.

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of Article X (relating to Snow Emergencies) shall be subject to prosecution before a magisterial district judge in the same manner as provided for a summary offense under the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure and, upon conviction thereof, shall be sentenced to pay a criminal fine of Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00) plus court costs and reasonable attorney fees incurred by the Borough in the enforcement proceedings.

## § 41-1204 Tickets in lieu of Citations.

(a) **In General.** Except in the case of violations of § 41-502 (relating to No Parking for Short Periods) or Article VIII (relating to Handicapped Parking Spaces), police officers shall place on any vehicle found to be in violation of any of the parking, stopping, or standing provisions of this Chapter a notice to the owner or operator of such vehicle of the date, time, and place of such violation. Such notice shall allow for prompt payment of penalties for the violation as follows:

(1) The owner or operator may, within seventy-two (72) hours of the time when such notice was attached to his vehicle, pay the sum of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) in full satisfaction;

(2) After seventy-two (72) hours, but within ten (10) days of the violation, the owner or operator may pay the sum of Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00) in full satisfaction.

(b) **Violations of § 41-502 or Article VIII.** In the case of violations of § 41-502 (relating to No Parking for Short Periods) or Article VIII (relating to Handicapped Parking Spaces), a police officer *may* place on a vehicle found to be in violation of any of those provisions a notice to the owner or operator of such vehicle of the date, time, and place of such violation, and a statement that the owner or operator may, within ten (10) calendar days after the violation, pay the sum of fifty dollars (\$50.00) in full satisfaction. In that event, no citation shall issue unless the owner or operator shall fail to make full payment of the penalty within ten (10) calendar days after the violation.

(c) **Citations After Failure to Pay Ticket in Timely Fashion.** Where the owner or operator of the vehicle shall fail to make payment of the penalty prescribed under this § 41-1204 within ten (10) days from the date when the notice was attached to the vehicle, the owner or operator shall be subject to citation and the payment of the penalty provision otherwise set forth in this Article as they may relate to the violation, *provided* that prosecution for violations of § 41-503 (relating to State Law Prohibitions Which Are Also Local Prohibitions) and Article VIII (relating to Handicapped Parking Spaces) shall be made under the state Vehicle Code rather than this Chapter.
