Ordinance No. 604

(Duly Adopted April 8, 2026)

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING ON THE NORTHERLY
SIDE OF COBBLESTONE COURT (THE INSIDE OF THE SEMICIR-
CLE) FROM 9 A.M. TO 11 A.M. ON TUESDAYS.

WHEREAS, Sections 3353(d), and 6109(a)(1), (b), and (e) of the Vehicle Code, 75 PA. CONS. STAT. §§ 3353(d), 6109(a)(1),(b),(e), permit municipalities to prohibit, regulate, limit, or restrict stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on any highway within their physical boundaries, if the designation is made by ordinance, official traffic control devices (*e.g.*, signs) are erected, and, with respect to certain restrictions, in accordance with an engineering and traffic investigation which complies with state regulations; and

WHEREAS, parking may be restricted by the Borough without an engineering and traffic investigation in order to facilitate maintenance operations or to eliminate long-term parking (67 Pa. Code § 212.114(f)(1)(i),(ii)); and

WHEREAS, restrictions for the elimination of long-term parking must apply only during short periods of time such as early morning hours when it will not seriously inconvenience local residents (67 Pa. Code § 212.114(f)(2)); and

WHEREAS, Borough Council has determined that the parking restrictions set forth in this Ordinance for Cobblestone Court should be established;

WHEREAS, on April 1, 2026, the Borough published a public notice in the *East Penn Press*, a newspaper of general circulation in the Borough of Alburdis, of its intention to consider and adopt on this Ordinance on April 8, 2026;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED and ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Alburdis, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. Codified Ordinances § 41-502(a) (relating to Traffic Control—No Parking Zones—No Parking for Short Periods) is amended as follows (with deletions indicated by ~~strike-outs~~ and insertions indicated by double underlining):

§ 41-502 No Parking for Short Periods.

In order to permit street cleaning and to eliminate long-term parking, no part of a vehicle shall be parked at any point within the following locations at the following times:

(a) Between 9:00 A.M. and 11:00 A.M. on any Tuesday:

1.	North Main Street (SR 3001)	Easterly	Entire length of street	
2.	South Main Street (SR 3001)	Easterly	Boundary between North Main Street and South Main Street	North-eastern curblines of Franklin Street (SR 3001)
3.	South Main Street	Easterly	The point one hundred nineteen (119) feet south of the south-western curblines of Sand Alley	Northern curblines of East School Street
4.	<u>Cobblestone Court</u>	<u>Northerly (the inside of the semicircle)</u>	<u>Entire length of street</u>

SECTION 2. As provided in Codified Ordinances § 41-104 (relating to Traffic Control—General Provisions—Official Signs) and § 41-1202(b) (relating to Traffic Control—Enforcement—Violations of § 41-502—Removal of Vehicles), the Borough shall erect and maintain official traffic control devices, together with the supplemental “Tow-Away Zone Sign”, for all locations ordained under Codified Ordinances § 41-502 as amended by this Ordinance, in accordance with regulations of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.
