An Ordinance

Regulating poultry, chickens, ducks, geese or other barnyard or domestic fowls in the Borough of Alburtis, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania.

Section I. Be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Alburtis, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, that it shall be unlawful to permit poultry, chickens, ducks, geese, or other barnyard or domestic fowls to run at large upon the streets, lanes or alleys of the Borough of Alburtis, or upon lands not in possession of the owner of said poultry, chickens, ducks, geese or other barnyard or domestic fowls.

Section II: Any person, firm, corporation or partnership violating the provisions of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction before the Burgess or one of the Justices of the Peace in for said Borough, be fined five dollars (\$5.00) for each and every offense and costs, and for failure to pay said fine and costs, shall be committed to the Lehigh County Prison one day for every dollar of fine and costs imposed.

Enacted into an ordinance at Alburtis this fourth day of June, 1915.
