An Ordinance

Relating to indecent exposure of Person, lewd and immodest demeanor, disorderly conduct, intoxication, and the use of insulting, profane or indecent language, and providing penalties.

Section I. Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Alburtis, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, that if any person shall indecently expose his body, or shall commit a nuisance by easing himself, in or against any building, wall or fence, at or near any dwelling house, or in or upon any street, pavement or sidewalk, within the limits of the Borough of Alburtis, or in any way lewdly or immodestly expose or behave himself to the scandal or annoyance of the residents of the said borough; or if any person or persons at any time shall be found in any of the streets or other parts of the borough, behaving in a disorderly manner, or being in an intoxicated condition, or insulting any person or persons, or wilfully obstructing the passage, or using loud, profane or indecent language, such person or persons shall be liable to arrest by any police, constable or other person having the right to make arrests, and upon being convicted of any of the foregoing offences before the Burgess or any magistrate, such person shall pay a fine of not less than two dollars, or more than fifty dollars, and costs or in default thereof undergo an imprisonment in the Lehigh County Prison of one day for every dollar of fine and costs imposed.

An Ordinance

To prohibit the obstruction of Street crossings of Railroad Companies and providing penalties therefor.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Alburtis and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

<u>Section I</u>. That it shall not be lawful for any Railroad Company to block up the passage of any crossing of public streets or roads or obstruct the said crossings with their locomotives, cars, or otherwise; and if any engineer or any member of the train crew or other agent or employe of any such railroad company shall obstruct or block up such crossings, he or they, upon conviction, before the Burgess or other Magistrate, shall be subject to a fine of not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) nor more than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) and costs for each and every offense, and in default of payment of said fine and costs to an imprisonment in the Lehigh County Prison for one day for each dollar of fine and costs imposed.
