Proposed Amendments to Borough Ordinance No. 31

Be it repealed Section 3 of Article 4 of Ordinance No. 31, approved the second day of December, 1935, which reads as follows: Water rents shall be payable to the Treasurer of the Town Council semi-annually, i.e., on the first day of May and November of each successive year. On all rents remaining unpaid on the first day of the month following the date said rents are payable (i.e., May and November), a penalty of fifty (50%) per cent, shall be added. In all cases of water rents remaining unpaid after the first day of the second month after the due date, the Superintendent shall upon direction of Town Council cut off the water from the premises in arrears, and turn it on only when all arrearages anc costs have been paid.

Be it amended as follows: Water rents shall be payable to the Treasurer of the Town Council semi-annually, i.e., on the first day of May and November of each successive year. Water rents pair on or before the first day of the month following said dates, i.e. on the first of June and the first of December, shall be allowed a discount of fifty (50%) per cent. On all water rents remaining unpaid, after such dates, the full amount shall be due and payabl Water rents remaining unpaid for sixty days after May first an d November first of each year, the Superintendent shall upon direction of Town Council, cut off and discontinue the water from the premises in arrears and only when all rent arrearages and costs have been paid, shall it again be turned on by the Superintendent.

An annual rent of Five Dollars and Twenty Cents (\$5.20) shall be charged for fire protection to apply to all dwellings, properties or buildings, including commercial and industrial

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establishments, who are not connected with the Borough water supply. All fire protection fees are payable to the Treasurer of Town Council in the same manner as Water rents are payable, and the same fifty (50%) per cent discount shall be allowed as in the payment of Water rents, if paid within the required period, governing Water rents.

It is hereby declared that this act shall take effect as of the first day of May A. D. 1938.
