ORDINANCE No. 118

PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A MUNICIPAL COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICE FOR GARBAGE, RUBBISH, ASHES AND RIFFRAFF ACCUMULATED IN THE BORGUGH OF ALEURTIS: MAKING REGULATIONS FOR THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF SUCH GARBAGE, RUBBISH, ASHES AND RIFFRAFF AND FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF SANITARY CONDITIONS ON FUELS: AND FRIVATE PRE MISES WITHIN THE BORGUGH OF ALEURTIS, AND AUTHORIZING THE BORGUGH SECRETARY TO MAKE ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS RELATING THERETO: PROVIDING FOR THE IMPOSITION AND COLLECTION BY THE BORGUGH OF PRES FOR THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE, RUBBISH, ASHES AND RIFFRAFF AND PROVIDING FEMALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDIN_ ANCE AND REGULATIONS THEBEUNDER.

ER IT ORDAINED AND EMACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Alburtis, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of same:

SUCTION 1 - Definitions

That the following words when used in this Ordinance shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this Section, except in those instances where the context clearly indicates otherwise.

A. "Ashes" means the residue from the burning of wood, coal, coke or other combustible materials.

B. "Garbage" means the animal, fruit and vegetable waste resulting from the bandling, proparation, cooking and consumption of foods and the residue from fruit trees located on the premises. It shall not include more than a minimum amount of free liquids. It shall not include food-processing wastes from industries such as canneries or packing plants nor large quantities of condemned food products.

C. "Rerson" shall mean a natural person, firm, co-partnership, association, school, church, institution or corporation.

D. "Refuse" means garbage, ashes, zubbish and ziffraff as herein defined.

E. "Riffraff" means all waste material which is too large for collection in a twenty-one (21) gallon container. Examples include: Christmas trees, furniture, tanks, stoves, large dead animals, tree trimpings, etc.

F. "Rubbish" means all waste material other than ashes or garbage which can be collected in a twenty-one (21) gallon container such as paper, mags, street sweepings, small dead animals, excelsior, straw, boxes, old clothes and shoes, leather scraps, pieces of carpet, grass, hedge trinnings, cloth, glass, china, wood, sand, brick, tile, etc.

SECTION 2 - Administration

A. All refuse accumulated in the Borough of Alburtis shall be collected, conveyed and disposed of by the Borough of Alburtis, provided, however, that the Borough Secretary may require any person or persons owning or occupying any premises whose accumulated refuse at each time of collection is in excess of six (6) twentyone (21) gallon containers or their equivalent by weight or volume, to personally collect, convey and dispose of such refuse in accordance with all Regulations for pollection, conveyance and disposal prescribed in this Ordinance or made by Borough Council of the Borough Secretary, or to pay such additional fees as may be required for the removal thereof.

B. The cost of the service for collection of refuse under this Ordinance as fixed from time to time by Borough Council of Borough of Alburtis as hereinafte, provided shall be borne and paid by the Owner of premises from which refuse is collected or upon which said refuse is accumulated and disposed of, and the person producing the refuse, or responsible for the existence or disposal thereof, or for whom such refuse is removed, if such person shall not be the owner, shall be jointly and severally liable with the owner for the payment of said cost.

C. Borough Council is hereby authorized to contract for the performance of the services provided by this Ordinance and to award a contract therefor from time to time for such period of time as shall be determined by Borough Council, which contract shall require the contractor to assume all responsibility for the collection of refuse in the Borough of Alburtis in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance and regulations, orders and specifications provided under the suthority thereof, and to convey, dump and dispose of all such refuse beyond and outside the boundaries of the Borough of Alburtis and to fix and regulate, in a manner not inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance, and the manner, method and time of collecting and conveying refuse, the type of equipment required for the purpose and the price to be paid for the performance of said contract and the time or times for the payment thereof.

D. The collection and disposal of refuse in the Berough of Alburtis shall be under the supervision of the Berough Secretary. He shall have astherity to make regulations concerning the days of collection, type and location of waste containers and such other matters pertaining to the collection and disposal as he may deem advisable, and to change and modify the same after notice as required by law, provided that such regulations are not contrary to the provisions hereof. An aggrieved person shall have the right to appeal against any regulation or order made by the Berough Secretary to the Berough Council which may confirm, modify or revoke any such regulation or order, provided, however, that no such appeal to Borough Council shall be permitted as to any regulation covered by this Ordinance, of any regulation or order of the Berough Secretary which shall have been approved by the Berough Ceuncil.

E. The Bereugh Secretary is authorized to arrange date schedules for the collection of refuse in the various categories and sections of the Borough and shal give public notice thereof. Such schedules shall provide for one (1) collection for each and every weak throughout the year. He collections shall be made on Sundays or the following holidays: New Year's Bay, Good Friday, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas. All collections shall be made between the hours of 5:00 A.M. and 6: P.M., provided that collections may be made after 6:00 P.H. to complete a day's schedule.

F. All persons within the Berough of Alburtis other than those excluded under paragraph A of this Section 2, shall dispose of refuse by the municipal collection service only and no person shall transport or dispose of refuse by any means not approved by this Ordinance or by the Berough Secretary.

G. The Borcugh Secretary is authorized to make regulations concerning the hauling of refuse collected cutside of the Borcugh of Alburtis over the streets of the Borcugh of Alburtis. No refuse shall be hauled over the streets of the Borcugh of Alburtis except in a watertight vahicle provided with a tight cover so as to prevent offensive eders escaping therefrom and refuse from being blown, dropped bpilled therefrom. No refuse shall be damped or disposed of within the limits of the Borcugh of Alburtis. H. Ownership of refuse set out for collection shall be vested in the Borough of Alburtis.

SECTION 3 - Prohibited Acte

On and after the date of the award of a contract for collection service pursuant to the authority contained in Section 2-C hereof:

A. It shall be unlawful for any person to collect, convey over any of the streets or alleys of the Borough of Alburtis or dispose of any refuse accumulated in said Borough in any manner not approved of in this Ordinance or subsequent regulations.

B. It shall be unlawful for any person to place any refuse in any street, alloy or other public place on upon private property, whether owned by such person or not, within the Borough, except: it be in proper receptacles for collection. No person shall throw or deposit any refuse in any stream or other body of water.

C. It shall be unlawful for any person to allow any accumulation of refuse on any premises in the Borough of Alburtis other than for the purpose of collection in the manner provided by this Ordinance, or by special regulation of Borough Council or the Borough Secretary. Any unauthorized accumulation of refuse on any premises is hereby declared to be a nuisance and is prohibited. Failure to remove unauthorized accumulation of refuse within fifteen (15) days of notice to either the occupant or owner shall be deemed a violation of this Ordinance.

D. It shall be unlawful for any person, other than the occupants of the premises on which refuse receptedles are stored, or the collector, to remove the covers of any of the refuse receptedles or to remove the refuse stored in such containers.

E. It shall be unlawful to place in any containers provided for regular collection any wearing apparel, bedding or refuse from premises where highly infectious or contagious discusses have prevailed, or any highly inflammable or explosive refuse.

SECTION 4 - Pees, Renelties, Discounts and Delinguents

A. The fees for the collection and disposel of refuse shall be determined each year by resolution of Borough Cauncil of the Borough of Alburtis. Fublic notice of the fee schedule shall be made by the Borough Secretary.

5. All bills for the collection and disposal of refuse shall be rendered annually and shall thereuson be immediately due and payable. All bills shall be payable at the Borough Office. All accounts shall be considered delinquent if not paid within thirty (30) days after the date of the bill, and accounts which are not paid within thirty (30) days after the date of the bill shall be subject to a panalty of fifteen per centum (15%) of the emount of the bill. If a delinquent account is not paid within sixty (60) days from the date of the bill, the Bereach Secretary shall refer the account to the Berough Solicitor with instructions to proceed for the collection of such unpaid charges, together with all penalties thereon, by an action in essumpsit or, at the election of the Berough, in any other manner provided by law for the collection of a municipal claim.

C. Pursuant to Section 5 of Ordinance No. 118 of the Borough of Alburtis, it shall be the duty of the Borough Secretary, ex officio, to collect all fees and charges provided horsunder.

SECTION 5 - Paralties

Any person, whather as principal, agent or employee, violating or assisting in the violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance or of any regulations made by Council or the Forcugh Secretary under the provisions hereof shall, upon conviction thereof by the Mayor or any Justice of the Peace of the Borcugh, pay a fine of not less than Five Bollars (\$5.00) nor more than Twenty-Five Bollars (\$25.00) and in default of the payment of such fine and costs of prosecution shall be imprisoned in the County Jail for a period of not more than ten (10) days. After notice, each day's neglect to comply with the provisions of this Ordinance or any such regulation shall be deemed a separate offense and be subject in all respects to the same penalty as the first offense, and separate proceedings may be instituted and separate penalties imposed for each such day's offense after the first conviction.

SECTION 6 - Severability

It is the intention of Bersugh Council of the Borough of Alburtis that each separate provision of this Ordinance shall be independent of all other provisions herein and it is further the intention of said Council that if any of the provisions of this Ordinance be declared to be invalid all of the other provisions hereof shall remain valid and in force.

Section 7 -

All other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Grimance are hereby repealed, provided, however, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall not apply to offenses committed before the award of a contract for collection service as provided in Section 2-C hereof, but such offenses shall be prosecuted and the prosecutions concluded under the provisions of ordinances in force at the time the offense was committed. For such purpose, the ordinances repealed by this Ordinance shall be demad to remain in effect.
