

ORDINANCE NO 177

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A RECREATION BOARD

WHEREAS it is the intention of the members of the Council for the BOROUGH OF ALBURTIS to delegate the power to maintain, operate and improve recreation places within the BOROUGH OF ALBURTIS, to a Supervisory Board:
and

WHEREAS it is the intention of the Council that any such Recreation Board as shall be herein created shall act not only for the BOROUGH OF ALBURTIS but, whenever legally possible, on a regional basis in conjunction with other similar municipal agencies.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDINED AND ENACTED by the authority vested in the Council for the BOROUGH OF ALBURTIS, as follows:

SECTION I - Pursuant to the provisions of the Borough Code, 1966, Feb. 1, P.L. 581, Sec. 2709, 53 PS 47708 through 47713, the power to equip, operate and maintain recreation places is hereby vested in a Recreation Board.

SECTION II - The Recreation Board Shall consist of five (5) persons, who shall be residents of the Borough of Alburtis. Three (3) members of the Recreation Board shall be appointed by the Council of the Borough of Alburtis. The two (2) other members of the Recreation Board shall be members of the School Board of the East Penn School District, or its nominees; provided, however, that such members or nominees shall all be residents of the Borough Of Alburtis. The members of the Recreation Commission shall serve for a term of five (5) years or until their successors are appointed: except that the members first appointed shall be appointed for staggered terms so that not more than one member's term shall expire annually thereafter. Vacancies for the unexpired term shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointment.

SECTION III - Members of the Recreation Board shall serve without pay. The Recreation Board shall exercise its powers and duties in establishing standards, qualifications and salary schedules for employees, which shall, however, be subject to the approval of Borough Council.

SECTION IV - The Recreation Board shall elect, from its membership, annually, its own chairman, secretary, and such other officers as may be deemed necessary for the accomplishment of its purposes.

SECTION V - The Recreation Board shall submit to the Borough Council in December of each year, an annual report which shall include an analysis of community recreation areas, facilities and leadership with particular reference to the extent or adequacy of the programs and

their effectiveness in view of the public expenditures involved and public needs.
