AN ORDINANCE providing for the vacation of a portion of Zinc Alley in the Borough of Alburtis.

WHEREAS, all the owners of property abutting on a paper street known as Zinc Alley lying between Stone Alley and Butz Alley (unopened) in the Borough of Alburtis have petitioned the Council for the vacation of said paper street.

SECTION I. That certain paper street lying between Stone Alley and Butz Alley (unopened) in the Borough of Alburtis, of a uniform width of twenty (20') feet, be and hereby is vacated and removed from the Borough Street Plan, said paper street more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a corner located on the southerly right-of-way line of Stone Alley (18 feet wide); thence, along the easterly right-of-way line of Zinc Alley, S 17° 00' E, 277 feet more or less to a corner located on the northerly right-of-way line of Butz Alley (unopened); thence, along the northerly right-of-way line of Butz Alley, S 73° 00' W, 20.00 feet to a corner; thence, along the westerly right-of-way line of Zinc Alley, N 17° 00' W, 282 feet more or less to a corner located on the southerly right-of-way of Stone Alley; thence, along the same, N 86° 00' E, 20.5 feet more or less to the point of BEGINNING.

SECTION II. The preceding description of the location and area of the paper street known as Zinc Alley vacated by this Ordinance is contained on a plan prepared by A. W. Martin Associates, Inc., Engineers and Surveyors, 126 N. Ninth Street, Allentown, Pa., dated May 1, 1978, attached to this Ordinance and incorporated by reference as a part of this Ordinance.
