ORDINANCE No. 228

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES, BONDS AND DUTIES OF BOROUGH OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES FOR THE YEAR 1984.

SECTION I: BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Alburtis that the following mentioned offices be and the same are hereby acknowledged or created, for the faithful performance by the holders of these offices, of the duties and functions thereof, subject to the requirements and conditions fixed by law, or ordinance, or imposed or agreed upon at the time of appointment, and that the following compensation is hereby fixed for the year 1984 as follows:
