ORDINANCE NO. 253

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ALBURTIS PROVIDING FOR INCREASED EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION.

Whereas it is in the interest of the Borough of Alburtis to provide compensation for employees which is fair and reasonable taking into account fluctuations in cost of incidence of effort; and the limited capability for a small municipality to project with perfect accuracy at year's end, both income and necessary expenditures,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council for the Borough of Alburtis hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION I: That the compensation for Borough employees as set forth in the budget for the current fiscal year shall be reviewed during the months of May and June of each calendar year for a determination of the desirability of an increase in employee compensation for the full fiscal year.

SECTION II: That upon a motion of Council a resolution shall be passed and duly advertised giving to Borough employees commencing the first day of January of the current fiscal year and to be throughout the balance of the current fiscal year an increase determined to be fair and reasonable and within the scope of budgetary projection.

SECTION III: Provisions of the current salary ordinance shall remain in full force and effect and shall be imposed concurrently with the terms of this ordinance.
