## BOROUGH OF ALBURTIS LEHIGH COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

Ordinance No. 347

(Duly Adopted December 30, 1996)

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING ON MAIN STREET (FROM FRONT STREET TO SECOND STREET), EAST SECOND STREET (FROM MAIN STREET TO MICA ALLEY), AND WEST SECOND STREET (FROM MAIN STREET TO WALNUT STREET) BY REQUIRING ALL VEHICLES TO PARK WITHIN DESIGNATED PARKING STALLS AND BY RESTRICTING PARKING TO VEHICLES NOT MORE THAN THAN TWENTY-TWO (22) FEET IN LENGTH.

**WHEREAS,** Sections 3353(d), and 6109(a)(1), (b), (d), and (e) of the Vehicle Code, 75 PA. CONS. STAT. §§ 3353(d), 6109(a)(1),(b),(d),(e), and chapters 201 (in particular § 201.21) and 211 (in particular § 211.6) of the Transporation Department regulations, title 67 of the Pennsylvania Code, permit municipalities to prohibit, regulate, limit, or restrict stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on any highway within their physical boundaries, if the designation is made by ordinance, and, with regard to certain regulations, in accordance with an engineering and traffic investigation which complies with state regulations; and

**WHEREAS,** when parking is permitted, nothing precludes local authorities from prohibiting certain kinds and classes of vehicles from parking for safety, capacity, or environmental purposes, or from installing parking meters and approximate pavement markings to designate parking stalls (67 PA. CODE § 201.21(c),(d)); and

**WHEREAS,** the Borough may establish new stopping, standing, or parking restrictions on State-designated highways within their physical boundaries without approval from the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (67 PA. CODE § 201.21(g)); and

**WHEREAS,** Borough Council has determined that parking is at a premium on portions of Main Street and Second Street, and that for capacity and environmental purposes should be restricted to vehicles not more than twenty-two (22) feet in length and should be confined within parking stalls to insure available parking areas are not wasted;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** be it **ORDAINED** and **ENACTED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Alburtis, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Section 129-25 of the Code of the Borough of Alburtis (relating to Stopping, Standing, and Parking Restrictions), as added by Ordinance 290 (adopted April 8, 1992) and amended by Ordinances 292 (adopted July 8, 1992), 298 (adopted April 28, 1993), 301 (adopted July 14, 1993), 317 (adopted July 12, 1995), and 321 (adopted December 13, 1995), as added and reserved by Ordinance 301 (adopted July 14, 1993), shall be amended by adding the following new subsection (G) (previously reserved by Ordinance 301) to read as follow:

## G. Parking in Designated Parking Stalls; 22' Maximum Vehicle Length

No vehicle shall be parked in any the following locations which is longer than twenty-two (22) feet from front extremity to back extremity (including any attached trailers and/or vehicles or parts of vehicles, and any protruding cargo), and no vehicle shall be parked in any of the following locations unless it is parked within a designated parking stall. All parts of the vehicle (including any attached trailers and/or vehicles or parts of vehicles, and any protruding cargo) must be within the designated stall; no part may extend beyond the front or back stall designation lines or the planes which pass through such lines and which are perpendicular to the street surface and extend upwards. The Borough shall paint parking stall lines at the beginning of each of the following zones and at intervals of twenty-two (22) feet thereafter to designate the permitted parking stalls:

1. South Main Street (SR 3001), easterly side from a point sixty-five (65) feet to the north of the northern curbline of East Second Street north for a distance of two hundred forty-two (242) feet (11 parking spaces).

- 2. South Main Street (SR 3001), westerly side from a point one hundred (100) feet to the north of the northern curbline of East Second Street north for a distance of two hundred twenty (220) feet (10 parking spaces).
- East Second Street, southerly side from a point thirty (30) feet to the east of the eastern curbline of South Main Street (SR 3001) east for a distance of one hundred ten (110) feet (5 parking spaces).
- 4. East Second Street, southerly side from a point thirty (30) feet to the west of the western curbline of Mica Alley west for a distance of three hundred thirty (330) feet (15 parking spaces).
- 5. West Second Street, southerly side from a point thirty (30) feet to the west of the western curbline of South Main Street (SR 3001) west for a distance of one hundred thirty-two (132) feet (6 parking spaces).
- 6. West Second Street, southerly side from a point thirty (30) feet to the east of the eastern curbline of Chestnut Street east for a distance of three hundred eight (308) feet (14 parking spaces).
- West Second Street, southerly side from a point thirty (30) feet to the east of the eastern curbline of Walnut Street east for a distance of two hundred forty-two (242) feet (11 parking spaces).

**SECTION 2.** The Borough shall erect and/or maintain official traffic control devices at all locations ordained under § 129-25 of the Code of the Borough of Alburtis, as amended by Section 1 of this Ordinance, in accordance with regulations of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.
