## BOROUGH OF ALBURTIS LEHIGH COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

Ordinance No. 425

(Duly Adopted July 14, 2004)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 41-802 OF THE ALBURTIS CODIFIED ORDINANCES TO DESIGNATE A HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACE ON THE EAST SIDE OF WALNUT STREET IN FRONT OF 231 WALNUT STREET UNTIL JUNE 30, 2005, UNLESS TERMINATED SOONER BY COUNCIL; AND AMENDING SECTION 11-107(a) OF THE ALBURTIS CODIFIED ORDINANCES TO IN-CREASE THE MONTHLY COMPENSATION OF THE ZONING OF-FICER BY ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS.

WHEREAS, Borough Council has received an application for a handicapped parking space in front of 231 Walnut Street to accommodate the parking needs of a person with a disability; and

**WHEREAS,** Council desires to establish such a handicapped parking space for a limited period of time; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to increase the compensation payable to the Borough Zoning Officer; and

WHEREAS, on July 7, 2004, the Borough published a public notice in the *East Penn Press*, a newspaper of general circulation in the Borough of Alburtis, of its intention to consider and adopt on this Ordinance on July 14, 2004;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** be it **ORDAINED** and **ENACTED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Alburtis, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

<u>SECTION</u> 1. Codified Ordinances § 41-802 (relating to Traffic Control—Handicapped Parking Spaces—Designated Spaces) is amended as follows (with deletions indicated by strike-outs and insertions indicated by <u>double underlining</u>):

## § 41-802 Designated Spaces.

The following spaces are designated handicapped parking spaces. A particular disabled person is identified for each space, and the designation shall remain in effect until the expiration date for that space, <u>unless terminated sooner by motion or resolution of Council</u>. <u>Unless otherwise indicated below, the length of the space shall be twenty-two (22) feet, and the center of the space shall be the point where the street curbline intersects the center-line of the sidewalk or other access-way used by the disabled person to access the dwelling on the designated property:</u>

<u>SECTION 2</u>. Codified Ordinances § 11-107(a) (relating to Salaries and Compensation—In General—Codes Enforcement—Zoning Officer) is amended as follows (with deletions indicated by strike-outs and insertions indicated by <u>double underlining</u>):

## § 11-107 Codes Enforcement.

## (a) Zoning Officer.

1/1/2003. Effective From January 1, 2003 to June 30, 2004, the compensation of the Zoning Officer shall be \$200.00 per month plus \$5.00 for each permit issued.

(2) <u>7/1/2004.</u> Effective July 1, 2004, the compensation of the Zoning Officer shall be \$300.00 per month plus \$5.00 for each permit issued.
